

Membership Scheme Terms and Conditions 2020

The following terms and conditions are an excerpt from our full terms and conditions which are available on our website: <http://www.dinton-pastures.co.uk>

Membership: The Activity Centre offers public membership [for a twelve month period] which provides the following rights and discounts:

- Access to changing facilities and toilets
- Free day tickets and safety cover during Centre opening hours (see website)
- 10% discounts on boat hire, core courses and clubs.
- 10% discounts on private tuition and teaching room hire.
- Boat storage for an additional fee

Membership is available by application and The Activity Centre reserves the right to decline an application at their discretion. Membership fees buy you a minimum of 12 months membership and are not refundable. Renewals are the responsibility of the member, although we may send you a reminder.

Membership, parking and storage fees along with the discounts are set out in The Council's annual fees and charges, which are available on the Wokingham Council website. Valid membership is required to take part in an activity where a membership discount has been applied. Car park permits for the country parks are available for an additional fee. Permit applications can be downloaded from the website. Important correspondence will be sent via email to dintonactivitycentre@wokingham.gov.uk, or by post to 'Wokingham Borough Council, Dinton Activity Centre, Davis Street, Hurst, Berkshire, RG10 0TH'. Parents and guardians have sole responsibility for and shall supervise their children at all times whilst they are in the Activity Centre. The Activity Centre cannot be expected to provide supervision. During The Activity Centre operating hours The Activity Centre staff will monitor the water and provide first aid if required.

Family membership is available for up to four people residing at the same address.

Concessionary membership: A discounted membership price is available for qualifying adults under the following criteria:

- Persons in full time education
- Persons over the national retirement age
- Persons on a government training scheme
- Persons on a low income, receiving a means tested benefit and who reside in the borough of Wokingham, paying council tax to the council.
- Persons under the age of 18.

Evidence is required that a person meets the criteria above. This should be presented with the application form and copies may be held for future reference.

Boat Storage: Boats must be stored in the designated boat storage area and show a current boat storage tag, which will be issued with your membership card. The safety of any personally owned craft and its entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner whether racing/cruising/moored or in the dinghy park. Boats remaining within the storage area after the membership expiry date will be charged £10 per week for up to six weeks. After this period, an additional fee of £110 will be charged and the boat will be appropriately disposed of.

Use of own boats: Day tickets allow visitors to take their own boat onto the lake during The Activity Centre operating times. Members receive launching rights as part of their membership. If they wish to take their boat on to lake outside of our operating hours, they must have a 'buddy system' in place. The 'buddy system' ensures that should the member get in to difficulty, there will be another person on hand to facilitate a rescue or call for help. All boats must be insured for third party liability, have suitable buoyancy and be in an adequate state for use on the water in the prevailing weather conditions. Swimming is not permitted in the lake except for supervised swimming sessions, or in the event of a capsized.
